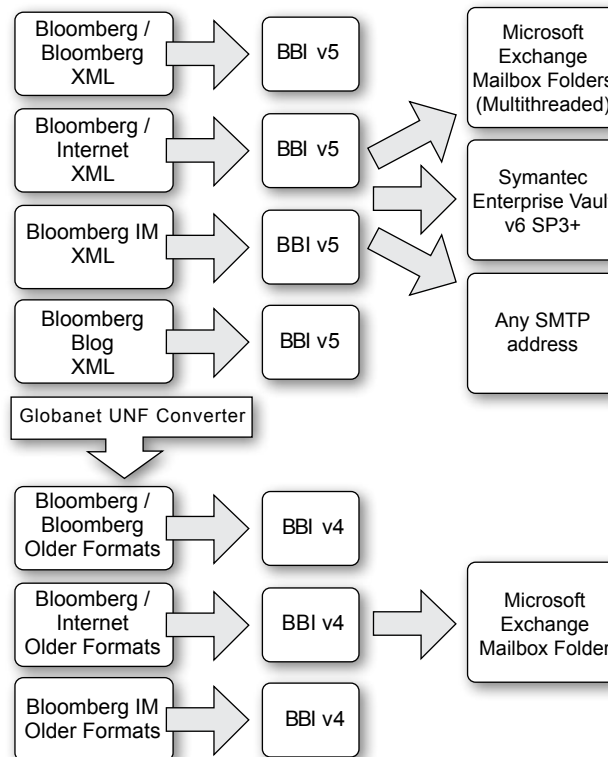
Extend Compliance to Bloomberg Data

OVERVIEW:

IT executives increasingly must demonstrate that they retain and can quickly produce data from all communication systems within their organization. Until now, communication over the Bloomberg network, carrying critical business information, was often disregarded during compliance reviews because there was no easy way to include this information in a granular fashion.

For years, Bloomberg has made available to its customers copies of communications traversing its network on a daily basis. These files (known as "daily compliance dump files", "Bloomberg message files", or simply "Bloomberg files") are aggregates of Bloomberg communications and present a day's worth of data in bulk form. Traditionally, if these files were included in a discovery search or other investigation, a hit on a single key word in one message would burden the IT professional with having to produce a large file which includes thousands of other, irrelevant communications.

Globanet's Bloomberg Importer provides the ability to parse data made available by Bloomberg and import this information as individual messages into messaging or archiving systems in use, thus reducing the compliance burden on an organization's IT staff.

- Symantec Enterprise Vault v6 SP3 or later (optional)

SYSTEM THROUGHPUT

Bloomberg Importer was tested to import 50,000 messages per hour using Dual Xeon processor system with 1Gb of RAM

FEATURES

- Obtain Bloomberg files via built-in FTP functions. Automatically tracks downloads and can purge after successful import to reduce duplicate data storage
 - Automated import of Bloomberg files in various formats (XML, Traditional, Default, Unified) historically produced by Bloomberg
 - Bloomberg to Bloomberg
 - Bloomberg to Internet
 - Bloomberg Instant Messaging

- Preserve chain of custody during import by
- a) copying Bloomberg data directly into the body of messages composed during import without any alteration, and by
 - b) handling exceptions via a quarantine system where only bad or corrupt messages are preserved for further processing and handling
- Notification of import status via emails sent to administrators reporting on number of messages processed and alerts regarding failures
 - Target import to:
 - Microsoft Exchange
 - Symantec Enterprise Vault
 - SMTP address
